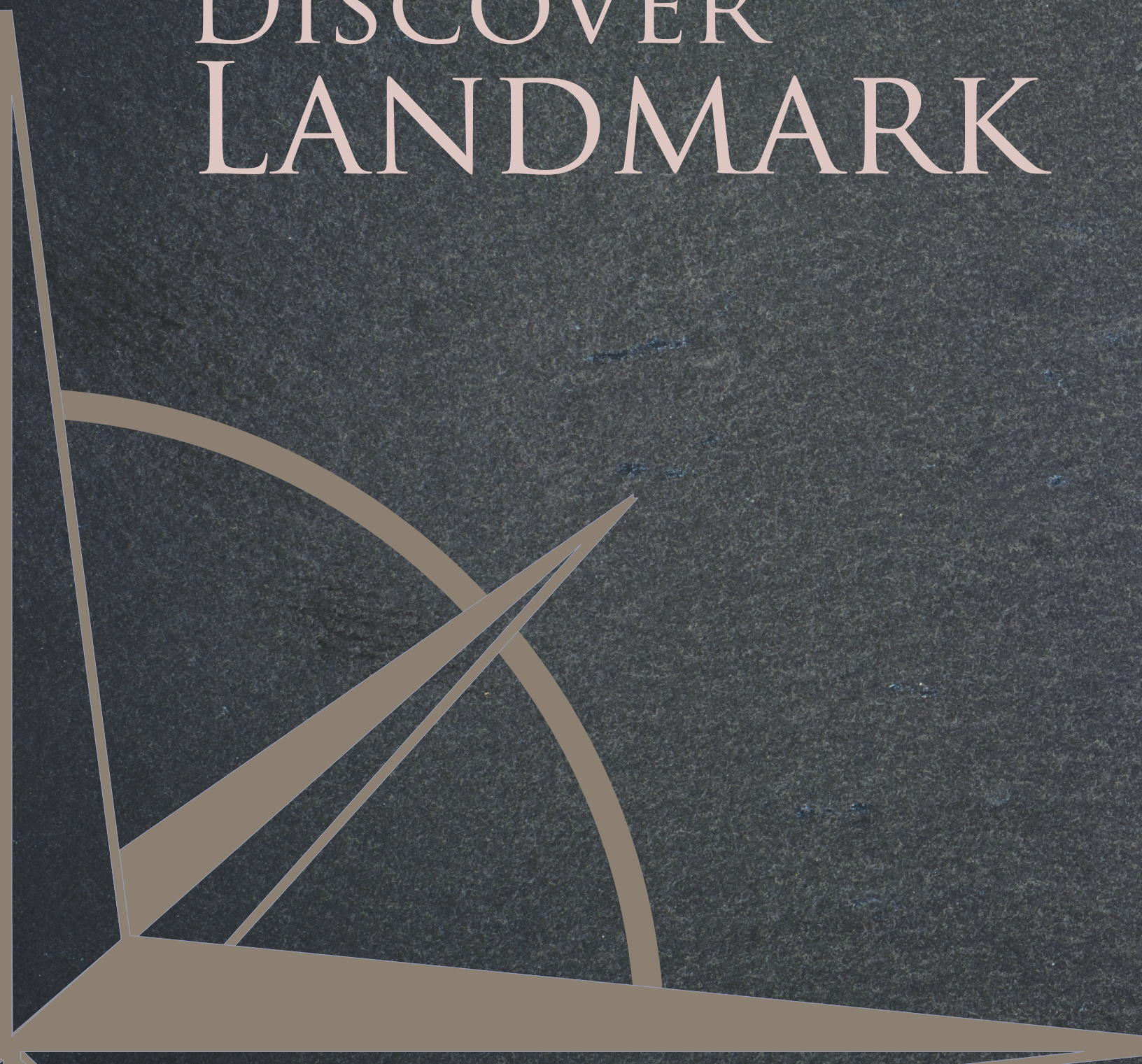

Worship Services - Sunday

Our worship environments help us center our hearts and minds on Jesus Christ. We do this, in part, through dynamic music, speaking to God in prayer, Biblical and practical messages, and Holy Communion. The message is available on CD at the end of service



at the Information Center in the lobby, or online at our web site, landmark church. We encourage you to participate in our services. We carefully plan our services to help each and every person engage the truth and Jesus Christ.

Bible Study - Sunday

We strongly value the study of Scripture. We are committed to spending time together as a church family to learn from it, so we can be transformed by it.

Every quarter offers a variety of Bible studies for all ages. The topics range from study of a specific book of the Bible, marriage enrichment, spiritual life and more. Some studies are grouped by age, while others are grouped by topic. Our gatherings last around one hour in length. This gives us time to spend a few minutes to connect with new and old friends, before diving into God's Word together.

Small Groups

How do you make friends in a church so big? How do people know what is happening in your life? We believe the answer is small groups. At Landmark, we offer a variety of groups on Sunday and throughout the week to provide a place for you to meet with others, grow in relationships and connect in a deeper way, spiritually. We currently have over sixty-five groups meeting throughout the River Region, as well as at our church building.

These groups provide a comfortable and safe place to discuss and apply spiritual truths. These groups also provide great opportunity to ask questions and find support. Our groups spend time in prayer together and often serve others together. When group members have a need, other group members respond. This provides a sense of closeness within the larger church family.

Many Choices

You will see there are many types of groups from which to choose. We encourage you to find a group that best fits your life situation and is in a convenient location. Feel free to visit a few different groups. If you have children, there are many groups that have opportunities for children to connect while their parents share together, providing opportunity for families to attend groups together.

We encourage you to contact a group leader and get the latest meeting time and location.

Care for the World

At Landmark, one of our core practices as a church is to reach out to those in need. Throughout the year, as a church and through various ministries in our church, we reach into the River Region to help and serve in many ways. We connect with local ministries and non-profits to help serve those with various needs. We also connect with Montgomery Public Schools for prayer, encouragement, and also volunteer for clean-up and service days. Many times, we are made aware of needs through our church members, and serve individuals and families in the River Region.

Landmark also has a thriving global missions effort. We support five full-time missionary families scattered throughout Asia, Africa, Europe and North America. In addition to regularly visiting and blessing our long-term workers, we often send out short term groups for one- to two-week trips. Both as a church and as individuals following God's call on our lives, Landmark is committed to sharing the good news of Jesus

around the world.

Disciple Someone

Spiritual growth is not a solo project. We believe in community. We believe in serving together. We believe all of these relationships help us grow, while we help others grow. There are times to be helped and encouraged by others, and there are times to help and encourage in return. As we grow in our relationship with Jesus, we become more like Him, or as early Christians said, "disciples." 'Disciple' is a simple word that means, "learner."

Jesus clearly tells those who believe in Him to be disciples and make disciples. In fact, Jesus sets the standard of discipleship very high when he says "any of you who does not give up everything he has, cannot be my disciple."

How do we live as a disciple of Jesus? We do it by investing deeply in the lives of a few people around us. This is how Jesus "discipled" others during his ministry.

At Landmark, we ask you to invest deeply in a few people. Spend consistent time with two or three other Christian brothers/sisters who will encourage and challenge you to grow in Christ.

We also ask you to invest deeply in someone who does not know Jesus as their Lord and Savior. Show them by your love for God and love for people that following Jesus is the way to joy and fulfillment.

Disciple others, lose your life for Christ, and you will find "the life that is truly life."

Children

Our children's ministry team works to supplement the family in their endeavor to lay a spiritual foundation in the lives of our children. We want our children to learn of God's love in a safe and fun environment. You will find a fully staffed nursery during Sunday & Wednesday Services. In addition, we have a children's worship service for children 3-5 years old that meets during both services on Sundays.

Learning & Loving Jesus

Each week your child will have the opportunity to learn a new and exciting Bible story. Our curriculum is simple and Bible-based, providing your child with truths necessary for building a relationship with God. It is our desire to help your family as you seek to build on the foundation of Jesus Christ.

Security

The security of your child while you worship with us today is one of our highest priorities. We ask that the same person who drops off your child also pick up your child. Our parental identification system insures the correct person picks up the child. Hallway security keeps a close eye on the children's area to make sure



no one wanders off. Each classroom also has a window so parents can look in.

Allergies & Snacks

Let us know of any allergies your child may have. We do

serve goldfish, Cheerios, animal crackers and apple juice, unless told otherwise.

Check-In

The nursery check-in counter is located at the entrance to the nursery, directly behind the front foyer wall between the men's and women's restrooms. All babies enter and exit at this location. When checking a child into the nursery, the drop-off person and your child will be secured with a corresponding bar coded label. Your child's name is placed on two labels; one for the parent and one for your baby. This is how we identify your baby and the parent picking up your baby. Please do not remove the label at any

time while your child is in our care.

To register your children, ages 3-5 years old, please report to the Kids Kingdom Security Desk located in the Kids Kingdom hallway. They will provide both you and your child with a corresponding security tag which must be presented when you pick up your child. Only the person with the security tag will be permitted to pick up your child.

In the Nursery (0-36 months)

Our foremost desire is for your baby to not only take their first physical steps with us but also their first spiritual steps as well. We begin with our

infants literally teething on the Word of God. During our Sunday School hour we use a developmentally appropriate Bible curriculum written by Palma Smiley to teach our youngest of God's love and His son, Jesus.

Age Division & Cradle Roll

Our Infant I room is designed for infants to crawlers. Infant II is for those babies who are walking up to 18 months. Toddler I is 19 to 24 months. Toddler II is 25 to 30 months and the Toddler III room is 31 to 36 months.

College



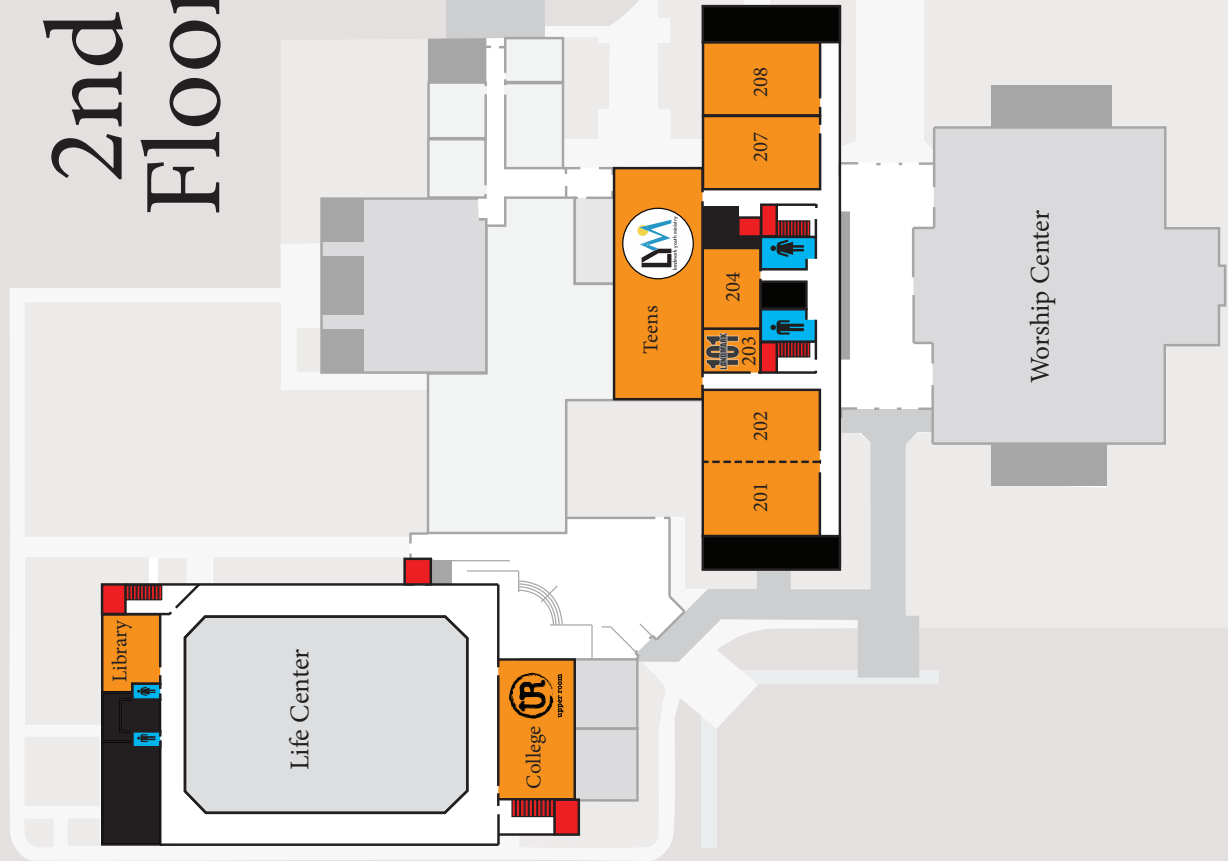
Montgomery has thousands of college students at multiple universities. Landmark's full-time college ministry staff is
